**NUCLEAR SAFETY POLICY**

Based on the consumer-orientation principle and being aware of its full responsibility for the possible negative outcomes of the results of activity of products supplied for nuclear power industry, the top management of JSC “Sumy NPO” (hereinafter- Company) declares its interest to ensure the production of safe, reliable and cost-effective products for nuclear stations and other nuclear facilities (hereinafter -NPP).

The major safety goal of the Company is to ensure such safety level when the risk of incidents and accidents at the hazardous production facilities is minimal and meet the state-of-the-art technological development level.

The Company’s top management, being a guarantor of fulfilling the requirements of the applicable legislation of the country of products consumer, its regulatory documents and safety recommendations of International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), undertakes the following obligations:

- To ensure the quality at all production stages by executing the common NPP quality assurance programs and developing quality assurance programs (QAP) (development/manufacture) for NPP
- To provide the production with all necessary resources (financial, manpower, material) for safe work, prevention of accidents and incidents
- To perform safety-important activity based on the requirements of regulatory documents in the sphere of nuclear energy use
- To decrease the amount of economic, social and environmental damage from possible accidents
- To maintain an effective organizational structure, a clear distribution of duties and responsibilities, proper qualifications and performance discipline of Company’s personnel
- To carry out the effective personnel policy based on a high-quality selection of personnel who are able and striving to strictly comply with the requirements of industrial safety, as well as based on the principles of constantly improving the level of personnel knowledge
- To form the personnel’s commitment to the principles of safety culture at all stages of the Company’s activity
- To make decisions based on risk analysis and technical and economic feasibility, while observing safety principles
- To demand from suppliers (sub-suppliers) to comply with the industrial safety requirements

The top management undertakes to explain the safety policy to its subordinates, to define their particular goals and tasks, to provide its understanding and observation in day-to day work.

The top management undertakes periodically to review the safety policy, demonstrate leadership in safety matters, including the setting and demonstration of high safety standards through personal example.
